



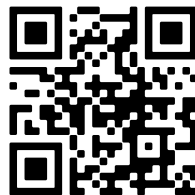

As an industry leader in education, the **National Elevator Industry Educational Program (NEIEP)** offers classes that emphasize the importance of safety, covering a comprehensive range of training for apprentices and mechanics.

IUEC members coming in to the trade are immediately enrolled in a four-plus year USDOL-Registered Apprenticeship program. Through college-level classroom courses, hands-on experiential learning, and online virtual simulations, the NEIEP curriculum provides apprentices with the theoretical foundations and practical skills they need to become proficient elevator constructors. Along with their classroom learning, IUEC members must complete 8,000 hours of on-the-job training under the supervision of an experienced mechanic AND pass a capstone Mechanic Exam to graduate to mechanic status.

The IUEC and its affiliated companies have committed to provide annual continuing education for mechanics. **NEIEP** has more than 40 classroom-based and online courses to learn new technologies, hone technical skills, or earn additional certifications.
